

4 STROKE does officially enter in 2012

After a successful experiment in 2011 by Ton and Mark Nachtegeller the 450 cc 4 strokes official enter the championship of the INTERNATIONAL SUPERKART SERIES in 2012.

During the experiment was shown the four strokes are reliable and competitive in the division single.

The interest which has now arisen provides sufficient confidence for the management of the INTERNATIONAL SUPERKART SERIES to add the 4-stroke engines to the division single.



The purchase price of the 4-stroke engine is between € 2,000.00 and € 3,000.00. That amount makes it for drivers with a smaller budget possible start with a superkarts on long circuits.

The technical regulations will soon be published. The regulations will be in accordance with the regulations in England.

These accordance between the national English regulations and international

regulations will give drivers, teams and manufacturers safety invests.

The rules for the divisions in 2012 will be:

- The actual Divisions for two stroke engines with Division 1, 2 (GasGas) and S (Rotax, Honda) are forward guilty in 2012.
- In division S the 4 stroke engines from the current experimental rules (see www.superkarts.eu) are added.
- The update of the English regulations will aim to protect vulnerable standard parts to keep the reliability high and therefore costs low.
